Dear Mr. Sarwark:

Thank you for your letter of September 12, 2016, requesting that the Libertarian Party's nominee for President, Governor Gary Johnson, be recognized as an Eligible Candidate pursuant to the Presidential Transition Act of 1963, as amended (Act).

As you are aware, section 3(h)(4) of the Act details the criteria by which individuals are eligible for services from the U.S. General Services Administration (GSA). GSA reviewed Governor Johnson's candidacy and the statutory requirements, and determined that he is not eligible to receive office space and services at this time.

My staff continues to closely monitor the situation, including ballot access, polling numbers, and his eligibility for inclusion in the Presidential debates. If Governor Johnson qualifies in the future, GSA will offer him the space and services detailed in the law.
